Hull Form

The Wave Scamp is a small general purpose launch which can be comfortably road trailed. She is designed to provide a stable working platform for inshore support operations in and around harbours or marinas and the larger 600 version has a raised bow profile for offshore operation. Her hull form gives her excellent stability, high manoeuvrability and excellent sea keeping.

She has built in buoyancy compartments and a raised fore deck to enhance performance. With a 20 bhp outboard she has a working speed of around 12 knots and a top speed of 24 knots with a 50bhp engine.
