## Fishing Workboat

### Hull Form

The Wave Fisher uses the highly successful 'Wave Train' asymmetric catamaran hull form and is designed primarily as a working boat for the commercial fisherman. The hull form allows the vessel to operate at either displacement or planing speeds and in rough weather. It is very robustly built to be capable of dealing with the rigours of commercial fishing operations and it has excellent stability to allow the fitting of lifting equipment such as haulers, derricks and hydraulic cranes. The vessel has a lowered central deck area to allow for hauling in close to the waterline and topside options include either forward or aft wheelhouse arrangements.
